

#### School Funding Under Threat

You may be aware, from media coverage, of planned government proposals for a national funding formula. The government has said that it plans to introduce a new national funding formula from 2018/19 to address variations in funding in different parts of the country.

Where it is right that there should be a fair system in place for school funding, the current proposals are causing huge concerns, as they will result in many schools in London having cuts to their funds, with some data showing that 99% of schools will have reduced budgets by 2019.

Reduced budgets will impact on the provision that schools can offer. Across Islington, families are campaigning with schools for 'Fair Funding for All Schools' with events taking place to support a fair funding approach. We are very happy to inform you that this week we celebrated our excellent attendance and punctuality in our celebration assembly.


This Week our Punctual Polly is very happy to be going to Y3 class and our Attending Alfie will be and going to Y6. .
